Seventh Sunday of Easter, 13th May

Acts 1:15-17,20-26

God always fills holes. If there is a need, God will call someone to help fill that need. Not everyone who is called answers God's invitation. Not everyone is called to a particular ministry. Nevertheless, God's call is always personal, always one on one, yet he uses others to extend his call.

1 John 4:11-16

The author of John's first letter used the argument from experience to promote his belief in God. No one has ever seen God, but the author claimed he was an eye witness to what God did. What he saw and what he preached was consistent with the experiences of his followers. The core insight into God's activity and intent was love. God sent his Son because he loved us. We experience that love so we should act accordingly.

John 17:11-16

Popular culture sometimes requires a "straw man," someone to blame for social ills in the world. Many times, those images of evil are real. In the twentieth century, the West opposed the tyranny of dying monarchies, the rise and fall of fascism, and the evils of Communism. Today, the West faces the curse of terrorism based on a radical ideology that hides behind the mask of religion.
