**DECREE AUTHORISING THE GRANT OF A PLENARY INDULGENCE
ON THE OCCASION OF THE RE-DEDICATION OF ENGLAND
TO THE MOST BLESSED VIRGIN MARY ON 29TH MARCH 2020**

In accordance with Canon 995 §1 of the Code of Canon Law, I grant a Plenary Indulgence to all Catholics within the Diocese of Arundel and Brighton who, beside the exclusion of all attachment to sin, even venial sin, on the Twenty-ninth Day of March in the Year of Our Lord Two-thousand and Twenty use the prescribed prayers for the Re-Dedication of England to the Most Blessed Virgin Mary, and who within a week prior to, or a week following this Act of Re-Dedication make their sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion, and pray for the Holy Father's intentions, reciting the Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory be. (*Indulgentiarum Doctrina*, Norm 10)

The Act of Re-Dedication should take place publicly, within the celebration of the Holy Eucharist, but in keeping with Canon Law, it may also take place privately; and, for those who reside in places where they cannot go to confession or Eucharistic communion at all, or can do so only with great hardship, they may gain a plenary indulgence without actual confession and communion, provided they have inner contrition and the resolution to go to these sacraments as soon as possible. (*Indulgentiarum Doctrina*, Norm 11)
